I began working at Sacred Heart after five years in the Finance Office at Our Lady of Mercy College, Heidelberg.

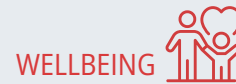
It was always a dream that one day I might end up back at the School our whole family has loved.

Classroom Learning Weeks 5 & 6

Take a glance at what your child will be learning in the coming weeks - be sure to ask them about it!

FOUNDATION

- **Religion** - Students will be comparing the qualities of Mary, mother of Jesus, to their own mothers. We will be learning about the Hail Mary prayer and exploring some bible stories involving Mary.
- **English** - Students will be learning about sounding out strategies to decode unknown words (CVC words), High Frequency words and spelling strategies for the words 'tap' and 'sun'.
- **Mathematics** - We begin their Statistics and Probability Unit, using the answers 'yes' and 'no' to answer a question, and collect and represent data.
- **Inquiry** - We wrap up our learning on transportation, and take a closer look at communication through time. How has the way we communicate changed over the years? What might it look like in the future?
- **SEL** - We are learning strategies to help us manage uncomfortable feelings in circumstances that we cannot control.

YEAR 1/2

- **Religion** - Students will be learning about Pentecost and begin exploring important Bible stories.
- **English** - In Reading, students will be participating in guided reading groups and activities around comprehension. In Writing, students are finding ways to edit the flow of their stories to improve their storytelling in line with other narrative texts they are familiar with.
- **Mathematics** - Year 1 students will finish their Measurement Unit by looking at capacity, and then move on to revisiting addition and subtraction strategies. Year 2 students will continue revisiting and learning new addition and subtraction strategies.
- **Inquiry** - Students will complete a mid-point assessment on what they have learnt so far around past, present and future. Students will then start to look at ways to preserve the past by looking at some key events in Australia's history.
- **SEL** - Students will be learning strategies to help us manage uncomfortable feelings in circumstances that are out of our control.

YEAR 3/4

- **Religion** - Students will reflect on their Eucharist and name all stakeholders. Furthermore, students will begin to explore parables from scripture.
- **English** - Students will continue to look at the Waves Unit. They will continue to explore migration stories and the different hardships people faced when migrating to Australia. Furthermore, students will explore how to write a resolution for a narrative.
- **Mathematics** - Students will revisit and revise multiplication and division facts. In these lessons, students will look at different strategies they can use to solve multiplication and division problems.
- **Inquiry** - Students will continue to learn about communities in Australia and the migration that has shaped it. Additionally, students will use their excursion to the Immigration museum to further understand different cultures and communities that make up Australia.
- **SEL** - Students will be using the Open Parachute resource to learn about friendship and how to be a good friend at school.

YEAR 5/6

- **Religion** - How can we identify Jesus' mission in bible stories?
- **English** - Novel studies using Literature Circle roles and responsibilities for reflecting on text. In writing, we will look at recording Autobiographies.
- **Mathematics** - Multiplication facts and the relationship between Multiplication and Division.
- **Inquiry** - Migration Stories, reasons for coming to Australia.
- **SEL** - Open Parachute: Individual strengths and challenges and a review of Camp.

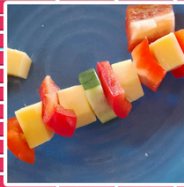

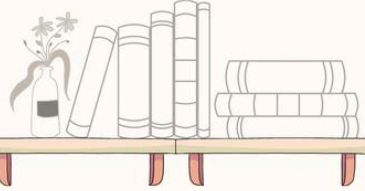
